



**Rules and Regulations
Qualifications for the St-Tite Western Festival
2nd Weekend**

Dates: September 10-15, 2024
Sanction: IPRA and/or IPRA Canada
Entry fees: \$300 + \$20 (fee)
Information: The Standings in each discipline will be taken on the Monday prior to entries for St-Tite. There will be 2 goes in each event with the exception of junior barrels, men's barrels, Team roping and Breakaway roping. Ties for positions will be drawn.

*Note: Only qualified rides will be eligible for the finale. If there is only one qualified ride, there will be no finale and the winner will be determined to be the champion. (*junior bull – Steer- Calf riding*)

Note:

- Selections will be made from those who have entered.
- **Ranking ends the weekend before registrations. If there is a tie in 80th position, a draw will be made among the ties.**
- For the 48 from IPRA Canada, only standing with money will be counted. In the event that fewer than 48 competitors have made money, we will fill the vacant places with invitations according to specific criteria:
 - Former FWST champions
 - Former IPRA champions
 - Former IPRA Canada champions
 - Former Wildtime Champions
 - Other distinguishing titles

9. Pickup Race

Qualifications will include: 40 Circuit Wild Time

Added money: **\$18,000**

Regulations:

Teams must have participated in at least one rodeo on the WildTime circuit to have the right to enter St-Tite. During each of the competition weekends during the summer, participation points will be given to each team (10 points per participation). At the end of the summer, all those who want to participate in the rodeo and who are on the official standings, can make their entries, even if they are not qualified. If a place is available, the next in the ranking, who will have made their entries, will have the place. If there is a tie in points, the competitor with the most money raised during the qualifications will qualify, if the tie persists, a draw will then be made.

Exchange Race

Distribution of participants: 40 Circuit Wild Time

Added money: **\$18,000**

Regulations:

Teams must have participated in at least one rodeo on the WildTime circuit to have the right to enter St-Tite. During each of the competition weekends during the summer, participation points will be given to each team (10 points per participation). At the end of the summer, all those who want to participate in the rodeo and who are on the official standings, can make their entries, even if they are not qualified. If a place is available, the next in the ranking, who will have made their entries, will have the place. If there is a tie in points, the competitor with the most money raised during the qualifications will qualify, if the tie persists, a draw will then be made.

How Points Work on for rescue race and exchange race only:

At each qualifying weekend, competitors accumulate points according to the following principle:

1. Participation points will be awarded for each weekend of competition. Ex. 10 points per participation per weekend.

Riders must have participated in one of the barrel competitions listed in the competition location section. On each weekend, riders can qualify for the right to enter St-Tite (depending on the results of the competitions). If a rider is already qualified in the 1st positions of the go, we take the following positions. The rider can present **a single mount** at St-Tite. When the rider is qualified, we go directly to the next position. During registration, the rider **can register with the mount of his choice**. If the rider is injured, we move on to the next person.

8 top in the average continue to the Finals,
Slack will be Thursday, September 12 for all contestants not in a rodeo.

Ladies Barrels

8 / rodeo on Wednesday, September 11 to Sunday, September 14 at 8pm;
8 best in the average continue to the Finals;
All the ladies' barrels will compete once in the slack on Tuesday, September 10 and then the best will run their second run in the rodeos.

Pickup and Exchange Race:

8 / rodeo on Wednesday, September 11 to Sunday, September 14 at 8pm;
8 best times continue to the Finals;
All teams will pass in the slack on Tuesday, September 10 and Wednesday, September 11 and then all the teams will pass again in the rodeos.

Men's Barrels

Slack Thursday, September 12 mid-day;
8 best times continue to the Finals.

Tie-Down Roping

2 go in slack;
8 best of the average advance to the Final,
The slacks will take place Tuesday September 10 (1st go) and Thursday September 12 (2nd go)

Team Roping

1 go in slack;
The slacks will take place Tuesday September 10
